Challenge

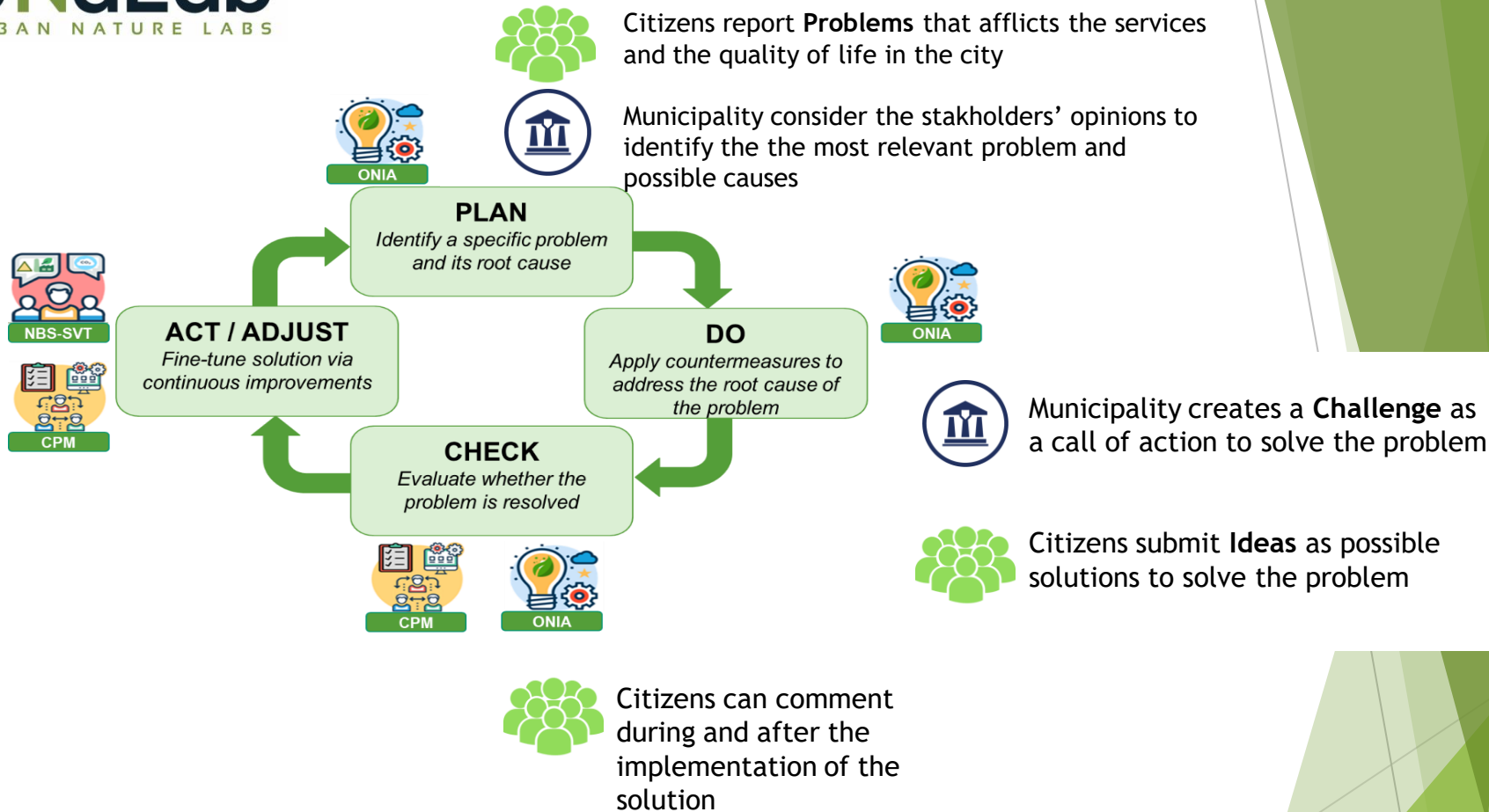
ULL manager creates the Challenge to involve the citizens to propose possible solution to solve the Problem identified.



Idea

Citizen suggests an Idea as a possible solution (technical or not) to be implemented to solve a Problem.

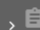

Objective : to collect ideas to reduce the flooding risks

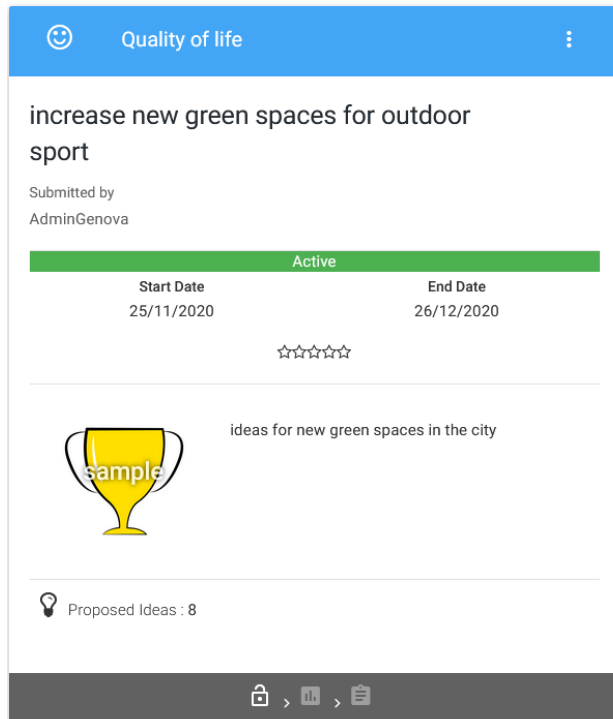
Received 4 ideas of possible solutions

Challenge increase new green spaces for outdoor sport

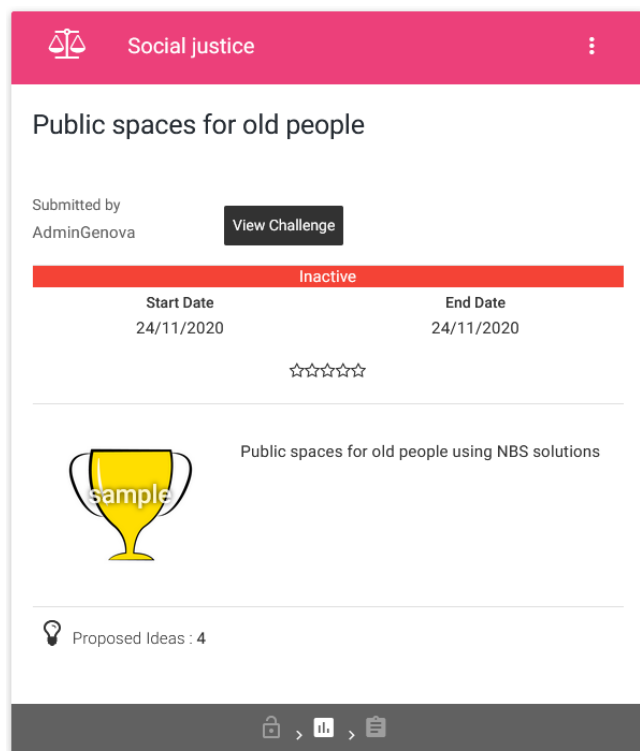
Objective : to increase the quality of life supporting the outdoor activities
