Objective

The 5th Buddy System workshop has the objective of gathering different experts from FRs and FCs in a round-table discussion to focus on topics of interest for the municipalities and to deepen into some of the unsolved questions that require a more technical insight.

Agenda

Talking points: How to convince councils and public to implement them in their buildings? Could it be possible to use public funds? How to build green roofs (or green walls) resilient to dry period (without any water supply) and heavy rainfalls?

Talking points: How to decide if the intervention is good enough as an NBS? Which criteria has to be set in the planning stage? (e.g. in the storm water management, in order to be approved as an NBS?)

- Presentation of topic n°3: **Interventions to increase biodiversity (5 min)**
Talking points: Which are the possible solutions to intervene in areas where green spaces have been lost and the vegetation has been altered causing the increase of desertification? (e.g. depopulated areas) Intervene trying to reactivate and repopulate those areas could it be useful?
